C R'S DEPUTY had good position to stalk the pace for a mile, moved to challenge on the far turn, dueled the entire stretch and prevailed in the final stride. BLUES CROSSING took command at once, set soft fractions, was hooked on the far turn, battled to the wire and just missed. CAT MAN had good position, saved ground, angled out, needed more. A. P. JEWEL was unhurried early, settled in the second flight, closed a gap late. EL BOMBA was allowed to settle, moved up on the far turn, flattened out. FORM trailed in a dull effort.
