ALL ABOUT ME stalked the pace racing two wide, gradually reeled in the pacesetter from between foes through the lane and prevailed in a long drive under strong handling. PLATINUM STEEL rated just off the leader, moved in tandem with the winner and pressed that one determinedly to the wire while gaining the place in the final strides. HEY JUDY sprinted away to a wide lead down the backside, slowed the pace in the turn while maintaining an open lead, drifted out slightly turning for home and dug-in gamely to be passed late. SOUTHERN FLAIR raced wide throughout, moved up to striking distance of the leaders in the early stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. PRIVATE BET moved up through the back half of the field through the turn and had no response in the drive. LIL MISS SASSY raced at the head of the second flight with no rally for the lane. MY COUSIN ANNA bumped at the start, raced evenly. VELVET DANCER was never a factor. HOLD THE CAT bumped leaving the gate, rushed up the rail to an early contending position and flattened out.
