Footnotes

CATS ON TOUR broke sharply, moved away to a clear lead, dropped to rail entering turn while slowing the pace, drew away when asked and finished as much the best under confident handling. HEYWOODS raced along the rail to press pace, settled just off the leader, angled out for the drive and finished well to be second best. BLUE DANUBE WALTZ broke in the air spotting the field two lengths leaving the gate, settled into stride steadily advancing up the rail, gained a striking position in the lane but had nothing left late. SECURE THE BORDER chased the pace down the backside, was forced four wide in the turn and finished evenly. AFLEET AMORE racing near the rear of the field made a mild rally down the stretch. SMOKIN'INTHEMEADOW stalked not far off the leader, moved up to challenge briefly on the turn racing two wide and flattened out in the lane while drifting out. T. V. TOMMY was never a factor.
