SHUSH UP rushed up to take command a few strides away from the gate, raced three wide through the turn holding his lead, opened a clear margin early in the stretch and drew away. BABY BUCKS away a step slow, settled into stride, steadily advanced circling the field five wide and finished gamely to be second. ANNATLANTIC broke quickest of all, dropped to the rail dueling for the lead through the turn and ran on well in the lane. SHE'S PARADISE rushed up to challenge for the lead down the backside, backed out from between horses on the turn and finished evenly. RUSTLER saved ground racing on the rail and had no response when called upon in the stretch. CHOIR GIRL at the rear of the field for the first half, made a mild rally passing tiring rivals in the lane. PRECIOUS HONOR posed no threat. ANNIE'S IN CHARGE with the early front flight, faltered after three eighths.
