NATIONAL DAY was allowed to settle down the backside, saved ground around the turn, angled out to finish full of run and get up at the wire under strong handling. BEDFORD ARCH stalked the pace, made a middle move on the inside, led between calls, battled but just missed. ZEPHYR HILLS had good position four wide, offered a mild rally. ROB'S BOY MAT chased the early pace before giving way. POLITE LIL SIR raced in the second flight, was no factor while five wide. CHIEF'S SWORD was hustled along, chased a fast pace, gave way. SHIPWATCH settled in the middle of the pack, failed to respond in a dull effort.
