AFLEET'S SECRET raced five wide, rallied at the quarter pole, dueled through the stretch and was clear late under a steady drive. QUICK TO CHARM stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, dueled through the stretch and yielded late. CURSESANDBLESSINGS unrushed early, then rallied late while five wide. J T KINGFISHER stalked the pace inside, then faded in the stretch. SHAKEYOGROOVETHING lugged out the first time down the stretch, dueled inside, then gave way on the first turn. HANGINGBYATHREAD was carried out the first time down the stretch, dueled outside of the leader, saved ground on the far turn, then faded in the drive. BLUE MON raced evenly.
