FATHER TIME broke sharply, settled back on the rail, bid three wide at the three-sixteenths pole and was clear under a mild drive. TURNTWO raced three wide, lacked a late bid and gained the place late. DARCY BOY saved ground, then lacked a late bid. IT'S A EGO THING and GREAT ADDICTION raced evenly. JETLAUNCHS HEART was clear early but couldn't last. DANCING IN GERARDA raced evenly. MIESZKO passed tired rivals. STUCK IN TRAFFIC was off awkwardly. GIUSEPPEGETTO and BARNFOX were not factors.
