SWEET ARGUMENT stalked the pace to the head of the final bend, took command in the turn, was engaged by the runner-up at the top of the lane, exchanged the lead down to the wire, prevailing in a long hard fought drive. BUTTERTART raced just behind the winner in a well rated third, moved with that one to challenge at top of the lane, drew even, battled to the wire and just missed late. COZY TOP settled early off the pacesetters, rushed up to challenge for the lead at the top of the stretch, battled gamely to the final sixteenth and weakened late. OUR KITTEN raced at the back of the field to the top of the lane and rallied mildly. FLOWERMING raced away into the first turn to set the pace to the top of the second turn and faded through the stretch.
