### Footnotes

ROYAL WAR ACADEMY stalked the early pace from the inside, reached a striking position entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and steadily drew clear. CRIMSON PRINCE well placed from the outside, responded when sat down for the drive but was too late. MOONSHINE ROAD up close outside, remained forward entering the stretch but could not keep pace. STEVEN'S AFLEET broke well from the inside to gain the early advantage, remained clear entering the turn but tired in the drive. VICTORY CURE was no factor. TEXPLOSIVE HALL was no threat. OUR LINDA was always outrun.
