WILD GOOSE CREEK broke alertly outside, opened a clear margin early, remained clear entering the turn, held a clear margin at the eighth pole and just lasted late. SCOTTIE stalked the early pace from between foes, crept closer entering the turn, dropped inside for the drive, responded when asked but just missed. CRAFTY MATCH up close from the inside early, responded when asked and finished well but too late. BURNING ELEMENT forced the early pace inside but had nothing left for the drive. U. S. S. GOLIATH well placed outside, had no late response. SHOOT WITH PRIDE up close early while inside, tired in the drive. FIERCE STORM was no factor. ROSTER MAN was never close. JIMMY JAMMER was off a step slow and outrun.
