RUNAWAY DIVA stalked the pace outside of the leader, bid at the quarter pole, got the lead late and lasted under a strong drive. SHANANIE'S HONOR stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, closed late and missed. SOUTHERN SWINGER bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the pace between rivals, was brushed at the three-sixteenths pole, rallied at the eighth pole but was outfinished. BLACK SABLE bumped with a rival at the start, raced five wide, then launched a belated bid. C J'S PRIZE bumped with a rival at the start, was unrushed inside, had a mild late bid but faltered. RUNWAY TWIGGY stalked the pace inside, bid at the quarter pole but gave way in the drive. LA SUPREMA was clear early but gave way in the drive. RUN FOR FAME was off awkwardly and bumped with a rival at the start.
