**Footnotes**

FT. DEPOSIT settled off the pacesetters down the backstretch, moved four wide under restraint for his rally, circled the tiring leaders at the top of the lane and drew off under confident handling. CHIEF EXCHANGER reserved on the rail off the early pace, made steady gains up the rail through the turn, angled out for the drive and finished well to be second best. CARTERS GAP stalked the pace racing three wide in the turn, took command at the quarter pole, opened a clear lead at the top of the stretch and weakened late in the drive. GALLANT PATRIOT pressed the pace from between horses, evened out when called upon in the stretch. FORK IN THE ROAD away near the rear of the field, posed no threat throughout. FLYING HION SUGAR was no factor. GERRY WITH A G rushed up along the rail to take the lead through the turn, checked at the quarter pole and stopped.
