GOLD IT IS veered in at the start, righted himself, was clear early and held sway under a steady drive. DRAGON HORN stalked the early pace between rivals, rallied belatedly but missed. GOOD NEWS BILLY stalked the early pace five wide, then lacked a late bid. JUST SMOK'N saved ground to no avail. PHILOLOGY stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. WEST OF ERIE and. PEARL'S SOULJA BOY raced evenly. SHREKRETARIAT stalked the pace inside, then gave way in the stretch. RIDIN THE LINE and HOT AIR were not factors.
