BASHFUL BANDIT reserved near the rear of the field for the first half, made a steady advance while saving ground in the turn, angled out splitting horses at the top of the lane and prevailed in a hard drive. CANDY SHACK stalked the pace comfortably down the backstretch, moved out two wide to take command in the turn, repelled the challenge of IMPASSABLE CANYON, and gave way grudgingly late in the lane to the winner. SHALER slow early, raced at the rear of the field through the turn, swung five wide a closed with a flourish to be gaining late. IMPASSABLE CANYON gradually picked up horses down the backstretch, made a bold three wide move in the turn, battled for the lead through mid-stretch and weakened late. BLUEGRASS BALL pressed the pace for a half, fell back through the turn and made a mild rally down the lane. LINSANITY chased the pace down the backside, was jostled entering the turn and evened out for the drive. ALWAYS FOR YOU was no threat. AIDENS BOY set the pace for a half mile and faded.
