**Footnotes**

VIOLA between horses early, dropped back in the turn, angled out five wide to find clear racing room at the top of the lane and won going away in a hard drive. PRIVATE CAUSE reserved off early leaders, saved all the ground through the turn while making steady gains, finished well up the rail despite drifting out late. EVANSVILLE ABBIE raced four wide throughout, moved up to challenge midway in the lane but lacked the needed late response. LITTLE B ROSSON pressed the pace to the top of the stretch, gradually gave way in the stretch drive and was taken up off heels of the runner-up late while lugging in. GRAND DISTRACTION was headstrong early, taking command down the backstretch, maintained advantage until mid-stretch and weakened late. BEWITCHING ANNA chased the pacesetters for a quarter and dropped out of contention early.
