Footnotes

S. S. LIQUIDATOR broke out at the start and bumped then was settled on the backstretch, started a run up the inside and moved up to split rivals in the middle of the far turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch then lugged in mid stretch and proved best in the best. BIG ROYAL ELTISH was settled then rallied three wide on the far turn making a strong bid and gained command in upper stretch but could not last in late stretch. DREAMINGOFTHESALE was bumped at the start then angled in on the first turn, started a run on the far turn while three wide and made a mild gain in the stretch drive. SHAKE IT OFF was allowed to settled then made a mild rally while four wide on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. BLUES CROSSING dueled the lead while two wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch drive. WILLIAMSBURG dueled for the early lead while inside, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. SAINT CHRISJON was unhurried early and was no factor throughout.
