ALLWEWANTFORXMAS raced up the rail to take command shortly out of the gate, was taken well in hand while maintaining the lead into the stretch and drew away under a strong hand ride. CARIBBEAN CANDY rated off the leaders, dove to a hole along the rail entering the turn, saved ground to top of stretch, angled out two wide and finished well to be second best. SEVEN DEADLY SINS stalked the pace from the outside, moved to challenge four wide leaving the turn and persevered wide to be third. SEEYOUINTHETOWN reserved along the rail, rallied mildly in the stretch. ARMARANTE away at the rear of the field made a late gain in the lane. HOLY ROYAL pressed the pace to the to of the stretch and faded. JAMRAA was never a threat.
