Footnotes

HOBO TO HERO stalked the pace three wide, bid at the three-eighths pole to get to the rail on the turn and was clear late under a strong drive. MY IMPERIAL DANCER led inside, was clear on the turn, angled out four wide in the stretch, then couldn't hold off the winner. BOOM DE YA DA pressed the pace outside of the leader, then lacked a closing bid while bearing out six wide in the drive. AOJA stalked the pace four wide, then yielded in the stretch. FLIRTING FOR LOVE raced evenly. MATTY'S SONG broke through the gate before the break, was reloaded, then was through early inside.
