DEAL ME ACES pressed the pace outside of the leader, bid late and hung. RUBY'S RED SOCKS was squeezed back at the start, stalked the pace four wide and then closed belatedly. SIR JOCK raced three wide and improved position late. GONE PROSPECTING saved ground to no avail. STORM LEADER hopped at the start. FOOLISH VOW was through early.
