SURREPTITIOUSLY dueled inside before drawing off late under mild pressure. SURPRISE STRIKE stalked the pace three wide, then gained the place late. FLEET BEAT stalked the pace four wide, then lacked a late bid. RHUBARB SAUCE dueled outside of the winner, then gave way through the stretch. MONARCH DESTINY raced evenly between rivals. KENIKO improved position late outside. ESSAY MONEY raced evenly outside. GRACE'S DEVIL was not a factor. COLONIAL'S SCORE was fractious while loading, then saved ground to no avail. HOME ALARM was through early and was distanced.
