LUCKY DRAGON set the pace while nicely rated, was hooked in mid stretch and prevailed through a long drive under strong handling. DOUBLE PITTSBURGH unhurried early, rallied four wide at the top of the lane, just missed after a long stretch battle. GRAEME WAFER contended throughout and finished willingly. GATES BLUFF pressed the pace, put in a bid in mid stretch, then was outfinished. SWORD AND SHIELD well placed, needed more late. MCBURNS was never a threat. ROMA'S WORLD pressed the pace and was through after a half. The rider of DOUBLE PITTSBURGH claimed foul against the rider of LUCKY DRAGON for alleged inference in the stretch. After viewing the tape the stewards took no action.
