HEY CUZ stalked the pace inside, came out three wide on the far turn, was steadied at the top of the stretch, rallied at the eighth pole and was clear under mild urging. ZIP ZONE pressed the pace five wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, vied through the stretch but gave way late. PROUD JARED veered out at the start, was quickly over to the rail, bid at the eighth pole but hung in the drive. MAYBE'S MASTER veered out at the start, then improved position late four wide. C B THE DEPUTY was clear early off of the rail, then couldn't last. UNBRIDLED PUNCH was bumped at the start, stalked the pace inside, bid outside of the leader at the five-eighths pole, vied, then gave way in the stretch. BAYSTONE showed brief speed.
