COUNTRY TOUGH was unrushed early between rivals, bid at the top of the stretch, was clear late and was kept to task. REGISTRY and. MT. FUGI rallied belatedly outside. ROMA'S WORLD hesitated at the start, then improved position late. NAJRRAIN stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. MONTE BAJO (FR) stalked the pace five wide, bid at the quarter pole, then gave way in the drive. ONE PRIZE pressed the pace three wide, then gave way in the drive. SMAK DAB stalked the pace between rivals, bid inside at the three-sixteenths pole but faltered in the drive. BIG GAVEL stalked the pace five wide, bid on the far turn but faltered in the drive. SIR DEPUTY was not a factor. TERREMOTICO dueled inside before giving way on the far turn. QUIET FRONT dueled to the stretch before giving way.
