Footnotes

CLEAR CODE moved quickly to press the pace from the outside, assumed command entering the turn, opened a clear lead and held well in the lane. KELLY'S LIGHT rushed up to take the lead to the half mile pole, settled back out of the pace duel to a stalking position along the rail, kept on through the lane and was gaining late in the drive. TRY ME raced in the clear three wide, moved to challenge at the quarter pole, drifted wider entering the stretch and evened out in the drive. WISHFULTHINKIN GAL chased the leaders down the backside, dropped back in the turn and came again with a good late rally. RUSTLER away at the back of the field, made steady gains to the quarter pole and flattened out. BACK IN THE PINK moved up willingly four wide in the turn and faded in the stretch. RUN THE COURT was never a threat. PERSKY'S HEART pressed the early pace between horses, backed out approaching the turn and quit from there.
