Footnotes

ONE OF THE BEST stalked the pace while racing two wide, rallied four wide on the far turn then was in a long drive in the stretch and proved best in late stretch. AARON'S CLASSIC dueled for the early lead while racing two wide, was well handled then dug in gamely in the stretch while inside but tired in deep stretch. EXTERIOR was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in mid stretch and closed ground willingly in late stretch. ART OF DIPLOMACY dueled for the lead from the inside, was well handled then weakened in the stretch drive. STREATERVILLE was allowed to settle while racing three wide, made a five wide middle move on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch drive. FOREST PICNIC stalked the early pace while racing three wide, rallied three wide on the far turn then faltered in the stretch.
