LEXINGTON PEARL stalked the pace four wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, then drew off late under a strong drive. TUOUBLIERASMONNOM was unrushed early, bid five wide at the quarter pole but couldn't match strides late. HOB NOBIN improved position late four wide, then lugged out late. KIVI KHAN was impeded at the start, stalked the pace three wide, then faded late. DITCH THE ACT saved ground to no avail. OSCEOLA GAL bore out at the start, led inside, then gave way in the drive. PLEASANT PRADO was not a factor. PROTHOE pressed the pace between foes to the stretch before giving way.
