TEENAGE DISTRESS dueled for the lead while two wide, was headed on the turn then in a strong drive in the stretch and proved best in late stretch. NATIVE SOLEIL was settled early then started a run on the turn, swung out three wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch to finish well. JUS TIGER'S GOLD broke slowly from the gate then was bumped very hard and dropped back, rallied on the turn then moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive, closed ground willingly in late stretch to finish well. FAST EL TIGRE dueled for the led while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch drive. WESTERN MUSICAL was very hard to load then chased the pace while racing three wide and tired in the stretch. TWENTYTWO AND TWO was unhurried early and was no threat. RUSH ROSES broke slowly then ducked out and was bumped very hard then trailed throughout.
