SQUALLER allowed to settle, made a steady advance around the far turn, finished well from between horses to finish on even terms with CHARIOTS N CAVALRY under a strong drive. CHARIOTS N CAVALRY stalked the pace from the outside, gained command on the far turn, finished on even term with SQUALLER after a long drive in a game effort. AFORE YE raced in the second flight, circled the field, finished well in the middle of the track to just miss. SAVVY SOLUTION middle of pack, saved ground while racing on the rail, lacked a late response. WISEMAN'S MILL was unhurried early, slipped through the rail, weakened in the drive. TACHYON was hustled along to get the lead, faltered. NO EXPOSURE void of early speed, trailed and had no rally. WORK IT was through after a half.
