BUKAH was well placed while racing three wide on the turn, rallied in the stretch and was in a strong drive to wear down ZEPHYR HILLS in late stretch. ZEPHYR HILLS dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long sustained drive but hung in deep stretch. TOURN AGAIN was unhurried early then started a run on the turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch but was too late. BARNFOX was saving ground early on then rallied three wide in upper stretch then flattened out in late stretch. J T KINGFISHER was unhurried early while inside and saved ground on the turn but was no threat in the stretch. FIREONTHEWIRE was unhurried early then swung out to be four wide in upper stretch and was no menace. Q COMMERCIAL JETTE dueled for the early lead while inside on the turn, was used up and faltered in the stretch. DEAL ME ACES bobbled at the start then was hustled along, was used up and stopped in the stretch.
