SAMSON ROAD saved ground, angled out three wide at the top of the stretch, rallied and drew off under a mild drive. OUT ON THE STREET was clear early, then couldn't hold off the winner. LIVIN N' PARADISE bore out at the start, stalked the pace, bid four wide on the far turn, then lacked a late bid. SPANISH STYLE and. DECISIVE CALL raced evenly. BALTIC AVENUE pressed the pace outside of the leader, then gave way on the far turn. CLOCKERS CORNER stalked the early pace between rivals, then faded. OPPOSITE pressed the early pace three wide, gave way and was eased.
