STORMY DEEDS vied four wide, bid at the quarter pole and drew off under a strong drive. DANZIG SCORPION rallied five wide at the quarter pole, then couldn't gain late. RUNAWAY DIVA raced evenly between rivals. REVERSIBLE ERROR improved position late while five wide. NEW ENGLANDER stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. MAJESTIC LORI was off awkwardly, bid four wide at the quarter pole but faltered. PEARL DRIVE led early inside before giving way in the stretch. MUSICAL MISCHIEF was through early. PYRITE BOB steadied at the half-mile pole in traffic.
