GOLDZAR was away alertly to press the pace down the backside,gained the lead entering the turn, drew off through the stretch under steady left handed urging. TRIP PERMIT had good position three wide, moved up at the top of the stretch,was unable to gain but held the place. GRAEME WAFER slow early, had a steady advance five wide,closed willingly. SUNSHINE IN unhurried early,finished evenly. PEACEFUL SLEWTION void of early speed six wide, passed tiring rivals. RUNNINGFORSPEIGHT had good position from four wide ,lacked a late response. ORIGINAL INK settled in the middle of the pack,saved ground but failed to respond. LINEBACKER raced in the second flight,was no threat along the rail. LION STRIKE set the pace, dropped back and stopped.
