VENETIAN SONATA was bumped early, stalked the pace three wide, rallied at the eighth pole inside and was clear under a mild drive. BLUSHING MARTHA was bumped early, stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. CONCEPT had a mild late bid between rivals. RED ONION LADY lugged in early, stalked the pace outside the leader, then gave way late. CARIBBEAN CANDY saved ground, then lacked a late bid. SUPER QUIET improved position late between rivals. CUTE CADET was bumped early. RED HOT DOLL was clear off of the rail, then gave way in the stretch. AWALKINTHEMOONLITE was not a factor. OPERATION BLING was squeezed back at the start. HOLIDAY SOIREE was not a factor. PUMPKINITIS saved ground to no avail.
