**Footnotes**

AMERICAN DOE settled into a perfect stalking position down the backside, remained in a clear pocket just off leaders on turn, swung out for the drive, took command down the lane and drifted in to interfere with BESAME SUANCES, causing that one to check, then drifted out to impede KISATCHIE RUN late in the drive and finished gamely to hold on for the victory by a scant nose. KISATCHIE RUN reserved off the early pace, mounted a five wide drive in the stretch, was caused to check in the lane when the winner drifted out, and finished with a rush when clear to just miss. CUP OF WHYS saved ground through the turn and rallied well up the rail avoiding all the trouble in mid-stretch, and almost overtook the top two in the final yards. TASTE THE TRUTH sprinted away to a clear lead in the first turn, was well rated down the backside to maintain his advantage, fought gamely in the stretch drive and gave way late. BESAME SUANCES pressed the pace to the quarter pole, moved to challenge for the lead at the top of the lane, was put to a drive lacking the necessary response, fought bravely on down the lane while tiring and had to take up when the winner drifted in inside the eighth pole. SOCIO D'ORO broke slowly, fell to the rear of the field while remaining slow for a half, and passed tiring rivals in the lane. GAME WAGER was never a threat. OLTON ALLEY chased the leaders for a half mile and gradually weakened while racing wide. The riders of BESAME SUANCES and KISATCHIE RUN claimed foul against the rider of AMERICAN DOE for interference in the stretch drive. Upon review, the Stewards disqualified AMERICAN DOE from first and placed him fifth.
