QUIET ON THE TEE stalked the pace, responded when asked, rallied to gain command, drew clear under right handed pressure. LAIRD'S QUEST broke slowly, was allowed to settle, made a steady advance, rallied to gain the place but was no match for the winner. PRAY FOR WAR raced in the middle of the pack, closed willingly. RONIN JUSTICE found his best stride late along the rail. SAINTHORATIO raced in the second flight early, passed tiring rivals from six wide. TIGER IN THE NORTH raced evenly. TWOBITHUSTLER was no factor. LOUIE THE LIAR had good position while five wide, flattened out. DREAM SMART pressed the pace, gave way. BOOMERANG STAR had brief foot. BADGE OF RED set the pace, faltered. CODE SENDER trailed and was eased to the wire when hopelessly beaten.
