### Footnotes

CRIMSON PRINCE broke well from the outside to gain the early advantage, dueled with LAIRD'S QUEST up the backstretch, dueled with that one entering the drive, lost the advantage at the eighth pole, responded to come again and outnodded his foe at the wire. LAIRD'S QUEST up close early while outside, engaged the winner from the outside, dueled entering the second turn, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole but was outnodded in a game effort. EVERMON well placed from the inside early, inched closer entering the second turn but was no match late. SAINTE MERE EGLISE chased the pace inside but had no late response. YOU THE MAN was no factor. WICKLOW STREET was finished early.
