DON'T LOCK ME OUT pressed the pace between foes, bid at the quarter pole, then drew off under a mild drive. CALIUS pressed the pace three wide, then couldn't contain the winner. CAPITAL GAIN stalked the pace three wide, bid six wide in the stretch but faltered. TENN ROSES led inside, then gave way late. SUMMER ROBIN saved ground to no avail. FEBRUARY CUPID stalked the pace inside, then faded in the drive. TASTE THE TRUTH was bumped at the start, stalked the early pace, then gave way in the drive. THE PARTY'S OVER was not a factor.
