FRONT MAN was well placed down the backside along the rail, swung wide on the turn, rallied in the middle of the track to gain command and draw clear. MR RICHMOND SIR set a pressured pace, dueled around the turn, dug in but was outfinished by the winner. QUALITY PLUS lunged at the start, rushed into contention, had good position but lacked a late response. NATIVE SOLEIL passed tiring rivals. TWENTYTWO AND TWO chased the early leader, stopped. DOWN HILL ALERT was no factor.
