### Footnotes

SMARTS was patient early while three wide, angled out five wide at the quarter pole, rallied and was clear under mild urging. DANNY NEWMAN was off a step slowly, stalked the pace three wide, came in slightly on the turn, bid, then couldn't hold off the winner. GOOD MOVER was clear early, then couldn't last. RIMRAM saved ground, bid at the three-eighths pole, then faltered in the drive. DRAGON HORN stalked the pace inside, came out on the turn, then gave way in the drive. BELIEVE ITS SUNDAY pressed the pace between foes, was checked hard on the turn in tight quarters and lost momentum.
