Footnotes

LUNAR FLEET hopped and was bumped at the start, stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole to vie for the lead and was clear despite lugging out late. AFLEET'S SECRET angled out six wide entering the stretch, bid but couldn't get to the winner. SILVER COUNTRY stalked the pace four wide, then bid late. TERRIFFICO stalked the pace inside, lacked room in the stretch, angled out three wide late and managed a mild bid. ORDINATION (IRE) pressed the pace outside of the leader before giving way late. HURLING saved ground, angled out five wide in the stretch but lacked a bid. STOP HUNTING bore out at the start, led inside, then gave way late. HIGH ASPIRATIONS was impeded at the start.
