PUTITONWAYNESTAB stalked the pace from three wide, responded when asked and wore down rival under left handed urging. KING SAMURAI was away alertly to set the pace, was outfinished in late stretch but was second best. SHMOOZ TALKER was void early of speed, closed willingly from mid track. NOAH'S HARVEST chased the early leaders, lacked a late response. MR CUDDLES pressed the pace, weakened. WAR WHOOP raced in the middle of the pack, had no rally. GOLDEN CAUSEWAY slow early, angled out for the drive and failed to respond. GALLOWAY PAIGE was no threat along the rail. MICKEE'S SAGA showed little. JUST SMOK'N was outrun.
