CERVEZA DE BARRIL bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the early pace, was steadied nearing the three-quarters pole in tight quarters, bid at the quarter pole to get the lead into the stretch, dueled outside of a rival and prevailed under strong urging. CAMPTON led inside, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished. WILLIAM'S KITTEN was unrushed early, then rallied late five wide. PROUD JARED raced five wide, bid at the quarter pole, then hung in the stretch while seven wide. JAZZ COURT bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the pace three wide, saved ground on the far turn, then had no late bid. EL DIABLO saved ground, then lacked a late bid. C B THE DEPUTY was off awkwardly, the pressed the pace outside for a half mile. CRAZY MONEY was bumped early, then pressed the early pace four wide.
