MOTION TO APPEAL bore in at the start, was well back, rallied at the five-sixteenths pole, altered course out six wide at the top of the stretch, refired and was clear in the drive. EXCESS TAD bore out at the start, led inside, then couldn't resist the winner. ZEALOUS YANKEE stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. PRETTY MR. D raced evenly outside. STORMOFTHECENTURY pressed the pace, then gave way in the stretch. LEROY'S DEPUTY was eased.
