**Footnotes**

HOTS IS HOT stalked the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn to take command then was in a long sustained drive and proved best in the end. TRANSIT OF VENUS was inside and settled on the backstretch, was shuffled back on the far turn and upper stretch then rallied in mid stretch to be closing willingly in late stretch. JET FLAG set the early pace under good handling, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. BLUEFINGER was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. SUNSATIONAL raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid in upper stretch but flattened out in late stretch. TOUR OF THE CAT was allowed to settled while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but faltered in the stretch drive. HUMBLE EARL was void of early speed and was outrun.
