FUTURE PRIZE stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole, collared the leader near the eighth pole and drew off late under a mild drive. SWEET ARGUMENT stalked the pace four wide, then gained the place late. GOING NORTH and COCOA'S IMAGE improved positions late. BAYOU JILL duelled early, bid on the far turn to be clear, then couldn't hold off the closers. BAD NEWS was not a factor. ALISON'S WYN stalked the pace for a half mile before giving way. DUBAI BEAUTY raced five wide, then faded on the turn. OSCEOLA GAL vied for a half mile before giving way. ECONOMIC RISK was not a factor.
