**Footnotes**

MONSTER SLEEPING raced away to take command entering the first turn, opened a clear lead while being well rated, responded when challenged at the head of the lane and held sway under strong handling. CLOUDY VOW stalked the winner throughout, was set to an early drive midway through the far turn, closed ground on the winner briefly in the lane but proved no match. KELLSTER broke through the gate before the race without running off, broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace and made a mild rally in the lane. REGINA'S WISH broke inward leaving the gate bumping with DISAPPEARED, straightened away, raced up in the turn three wide to stalk the early pace, and leveled off racing evenly. DISAPPEARED was squeezed at the start while bumped by rival, dropped back to the rear of the field and was no threat. The rider of DISAPPEARED lodged a claim of foul for interference at the start against REGINA'S WISH, after review by the STEWARDS the objection was overruled.
