COWETA saved ground, bid at the half-mile pole, angled out five wide at the top of the stretch, rallied and was up late. RADIANT SKY led inside but couldn't hold off the winner. WEKIVA'S ILEAN raced three wide, bid late but was no match for the top two. CUTE CADET stalked the pace three wide, was carried out five wide at the top of the stretch, then lacked a bid. SIXTY ACRES pressed the early pace outside of the leader, gave way and returned bleeding, bilaterally. RACINDA stalked the pace five wide before fading in the drive. SUPERTUNIA was not a factor. INVULNERABLE veered in at the start, then saved ground to no avail. ALWAYSINMYDREAMS was not a factor.
