MY LUCA stalked the pace four wide, rallied at the top of the stretch, then ducked out slightly and was clear late under steady urging. MAY FOURTEEN vied three wide, then couldn't hold off the winner. NASTY BOY pressed the pace three wide, then couldn't match strides in the drive. BRASS BUCKLE raced evenly between foes. ITTAI pressed the pace inside, then gave way late. BORN A HERO was bumped at the start, then raced evenly between foes. AMERICAN BUFFALO saved ground to no avail. OLTON ALLEY improved position late nine wide. FLYINGTOBECHILDERS was not a factor. BIG RON WEST stalked the pace between foes, then was steadied on the turn and gave way.
