WHYPRINCESSWHY was off awkwardly, pressed the pace, bid between rivals at the half-mile marker, was clear in the stretch and held sway under a mild drive. DOUBLENODOUBLE saved ground,bid at the eighth pole for wide, then hung in the late yards. NEWFOUND STAR stalked the pace five wide but lacked a late bid. MISS MUDDY LIGHT stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. BUTTONFRONT stalked the pace between rivals, but lacked a late bid. RUNWAY TWIGGY saved ground to no avail. GHOST TOWN KAT was not a factor. MAIA'S STAR vied inside, then gave way in the drive. RED'S KITTY HAWK stalked the early pace three wide before fading.
