Footnotes

WOODLAND NATIVE reserved off the early pace near the rear of field, swung out for the drive, came charging on the outside to be going away at the wire in a well managed ride. MOONSHINE BLUES tracked the leaders racing three wide through the turn, moved to challenge the pacesetter in mid-stretch, wore that one down only to be outfinished by the winner. FIFTYNINE rushed up to take command nearing the half mile pole, dueled for the lead through the turn, disposed of the pace challenger at the top of the lane, opened a clear lead at the eighth pole and weakened late. ZIG ZIP stalked the leaders from the rail, moved to a striking position at the top of the lane, wandered out and back in down the lane and lacked the necessary finishing kick. KING OF THE FAERY engaged the pacesetter leaving the half mile pole, dueled through the turn and tired in the lane. GOOD TO THE NTH showed speed for a half and faded. PEARL'S SOULJA BOY raced evenly. CRUISINFORCADDIES was never a factor.
